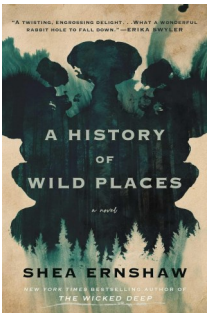
## LEGO at the Library
